

Sample Index of Proper Names

Instructions: Decide whether you'd like to list first lines, titles, or incipits for your texts. Titles should be italicized; incipits and first lines should be in roman. Format the page in two columns, with entries listed on the left. Entries should be alphabetized. In the right column, format the column heading in small caps (as "page" is done, below). From each entry, tab over to the second column and add the relevant location information.

Location information is flexible. Here, page numbers are given, but alternatives could include folio numbers within the base manuscript or editorial numbering (like the article numbers which follow each entry, below).
