

Sample Index of Proper Names

Instructions: List entries alphabetically. Each entry should include a boldfaced headword, variant spellings (listed in parentheses, separated by commas, and alphabetized) and the location (line or paragraph numbers) for each appearance. You may decide whether to include just the first instance or all instances within your text. Variant spellings should also be listed as separate entries, cross-referenced to the main spelling; these entries should not include location information. If necessary, include a brief description of the headword (as in the sample below), though such descriptions are not encouraged.

If the original text is not in English but in facing-page translation, give the original language form as a headword and list the English translation in a separate headword, which is boldfaced and italic. See **Hope** and **William**, below. If the translated form is identical to the original language, give both within the same entry. See **Adam**, below.

Acula: Daughter of King Finlak of Ireland, rival lover to Rimmild for Horn's affections. 790, 817, 832

Athelston: One of Horn's eight childhood companions, goes to Brittany with Gariis. 29, 458

Bitterfer: Sword given to Horn by Rimmild, crafted by Weland, of the same making as Miming. 403

Blakeown More: Blakey Moor, North Yorkshire. 110

Blavain: Hatheolf's sword, which Horn recovers when he avenges his father by slaying Malkan. 804

Bretein: Brittany, France. 457

Clifland: Cleveland region in North Yorkshire. 54, 70

Cornwayle: Cornwall, southwest England. 1075

Danmark: Denmark. 49

Elidan (Elydan): King in Wales, father to Finlak. 646, 663, 667, 747

Esperance: the female personification of the deity Hope. 500

Ferwele: A Norse-Gael king from Ireland; sidekick to Malkan, partnered with Winwald. 151

Finlak (Finlac, Finlawe): An Irish king whom Horn defends; son to King Elidan in Wales. 697, 703, 733, 737, 751, 769, 787, 808

Gariis: One of Horn's eight childhood companions, goes to Brittany with Athelstan. 30, 457

Godebunde: Horn's alias that he uses as a quest name in Wales and Ireland. 602, 607, 641, 678
